

Yes on 26?

Do you fully understand what you're saying "yes" to?

Yes – I am going against the advice of the Mississippi State Medical Association.

Yes – I am going against the advice of the Mississippi Nurses Association.

I understand that the passage of 26 might result in a mandate for women who already have IUDs to go to the hospital and be forced to have them removed.

If you vote "yes" on Initiative 26, you will be voting "yes" to each of the above statements. None of these statements are "propaganda" or "scare tactics." Every statement above is a **fact** which you can research online – most of them are on the "Yes on 26" website itself.

As you can see, this proposed amendment goes **far beyond abortion**. It endangers the health, well-being, and lives of Mississippi women.
